

## BUILDING IN COLOR

Building in Color was written at the request of the many Building Blocks knitters who wanted to continue growing their knitting skills. This new series is the perfect follow-up sequence for Building Blocks graduates. Building in Color introduces new stitches and techniques while exploring the wonderful world of color knitting. The panels are arranged in a sequence that is designed to build knitters' confidence while expertly managing multiple yarns during the creation of a colorful sampler blanket.

## BASIC SOCK SERIES

In this 3-session class we will learn to knit a basic sock from the top down. The class project is a toddler size sock knit with worsted weight yarn. You will also receive patterns for adult socks in both worsted and sock weight yarns.

# KNITTING BOOT CAMP

Already taken Knitting 101, and aren't sure how to proceed? Knitting Boot Camp is an exciting new series designed for beginning knitters! In one month, you'll go from knitting nothing to knitting know-how! Learn foundational knitting techniques while creating two fun and easy projects (hat and fingerless mitts) that you can wear or give as a gift.

Prerequisites: Knitting 101 or permission of instructor

Supplies list:

- 1 skein Simplicor yarn (2 skeins optional for two-colored hat)
- 1 skein Simplicity
- 1 US 8 16" circular needle
- 1 set of at least 4 US 8 DPNs
- 1 set of US 6 straight needles
- Supplies from Knitting 101 (book, yarn, needles to practice)

Class time: Three 2-hour sessions

## BUILDING BLOCKS

Building Blocks was created to move the new knitter beyond the basics by introducing the major knitting techniques in a systematic approach. Each block builds upon the skills of the previous block, allowing the knitter to gain confidence and knowledge while working toward a beautiful sampler afghan (or two baby blankets).

The 12 blocks in this project naturally lend themselves to a "Block of the Month" series. Having to complete one 12" square per month seems to suit most knitters. The time-challenged knitter is able to find enough time in the month for this amount of knitting. The prolific knitter can easily finish this block in the month and return to other projects while waiting for the next class.

## KNITTING 101

Jump into knitting with this foundation building class. We will go over knitting terminology, learn how to cast on, knit, and bind off. Class fee includes "Learn to Knit" book, needles, & Simplicor yarn from Skacel.

Prerequisites: None

Materials: All supplies (Book, Needles, and Yarn ) will be provided.

Class time: 1.5 hours

Cost: \$35

## ENTRELAC WORKSHOP

If you can knit and purl, you can knit entrelac! In this four hour workshop Michele will teach you the basics of entrelac knitting as you make a coffee sleeve from the book *Entree to Entrelac*. We will go over the structure of entrelac, yarn selection, how to knit the different components, and even knitting in both directions. Book is included in class fee, so all you need to bring are US9 double point needles, 100% wool (feltable) worsted weight yarn, and your eagerness to learn! **BONUS:** You will receive a cowl pattern at the end of class that you can knit using the techniques that you just learned.



**Prerequisite Skills:** Attendees must be comfortable knitting and purling

**Supplies list:** Book is included in class fee and will be given out in class. Please bring:

- US 9 DPNS
- 2 colors of 100% wool (feltable) worsted weight yarn

**Class time:** 3.5 - 4 hours

**Cost:** \$50

## SHAWL CLASS

Ready to knit your first shawl? This class will walk you through "Cinder" from the book *Sock Yarn Shawls II*. We will go over the garter tab cast on, using stitch markers, yarn overs, reading charts, sk2p, the importance of blocking, and more! Class participants will receive \$10 off the purchase of the book *Sock Yarn Shawls II*.



**Prerequisite Skills:** Attendees must be comfortable knitting and purling

**Supplies List:**

- *Sock-Yarn Shawls II* book
- Approximately 430 yards of sock yarn
- US 4, 24" or longer circular needle (or size needed to obtain gauge of 22 sts and 32 rows = 4" in st st)
- 4 stitch markers

**Class time:** 2 hours

**Cost:** \$20

## FIXING MISTAKES

You've been asking for it, so we're offering it! Here is a chance to learn how to fix common mistakes that may be driving you mad! In this class, we will be going over picking up a dropped stitch, carefully un-knitting (aka 'tinking'), ripping back several rows (aka frogging), placing a lifeline, changing a knit to a purl stitch, and more!

**Prerequisite Skills:** Attendees must be confident knitting and purling

**Supplies List:**

- completed homework using worsted weight and US 6 needles (please see website for homework)
- crochet hook (size D, E, F, or G)
- dpn (size 6 or smaller)
- point protectors
- scissors
- tapestry needle
- smooth yarn that is thinner than yarn used for homework and of a contrasting color

**Class time:** 2 hours

**Cost:** \$20

## MAGIC LOOP MITTENS

Keep those fingers and hands toasty warm with a pair of hand-knit mittens! Learn how to make this classic gift in this two-session class. Techniques covered include:

- knitting in the round with Magic Loop
- how to make a thumb gusset
- using a stitch holder
- pick up and knit
- spit splice
- kitchener stitch

**Pre-requisite Skills:**

Students should be comfortable knitting, purling, casting on, and knitting in the round on DPN's. If you can complete the pre-class homework, you have the skills!

**SuppliesList:** Pattern is included and will be provided at class. Class attendees will need to bring the following:

- Completed homework (please see website for homework)
- 2 skeins Lana Grande yarn from Cascade
- US 10 circular needle, 32" or longer
- US 10 DPN's
- stitch holder, stitch marker, tapestry needle, scissors

**Class time:** Two 2-hour sessions

**Cost:** \$35





## BRIOCHE BASICS AND BEYOND

One touch is all it takes to fall in love with reversible brioche fabric. Learn the basics of this textured technique as you knit two sample swatches and a two-color cowl. You'll learn the "rules" of brioche knitting, as well as all of the individual stitches and techniques you need to create this inviting combination of stitches, increases, decreases, two-color Italian cast-on, syncopated brioche, and more!. Michele will demonstrate both English and continental techniques in this 3-session class. \$50



Prerequisite Skills: Class attendees must be able to cast on, knit, purl, and bind off.

Supplies / Materials:

- 2 contrasting colors of Simpliworsted yarn
- US 5, 16" circular needle
- US 5 or 6 DPN's (for swatches)
- 2 contrasting colors of worsted weight wool or Simpliworsted yarn (for swatches)

Class time: Three 2-hour sessions

Cost: \$50

## MAGICAL MOBIUS CLASS

In knitting, the mobius is a simple and graceful form of knitting. Using a 47-inch circular needle, you do a mobius cast on, then knit. A mobius magically mirrors itself along its "equator" as it grows, and has one continuous surface and one continuous edge. Many knitters believe that twisting a circular join creates a mobius; it does not.

Pre-requisite Skills:

All students must be able to knit, purl, cast on and join for knitting in the round prior to attending class.

Supplies List: Patterns are included in price of class and will be provided at the class. Class attendees will need to bring the following:

- four balls (one ball each of four colors) Cashmere Queen
- US 6, 47" circular needles
- stitch marker

Class time: 2 hours

## STRANDED SLIPPER CLASS



Learn stranded knitting (sometimes called Fair Isle) and how to turn a heel in this two-hour class with Michele. Book is included in class fee, so all you need to bring to class are the materials listed below and your eagerness to learn!

Pre-requisite Skills: Class attendees must be comfortable with the knit stitch and knitting in the round.

Supplies List:

- US 10 DPN's and 16" circular (or size needed to obtain gauge of 14 - 16 sts per 4 inches)
- Two colors of 100% wool worsted/Aran weight yarn (Michele enjoyed using Maxima by Manos Del Uruguay)
- stitch marker, scissors

Class time: 3 - 4 hours

Cost: \$50 (book is included in class fee)



## INTARSIA

Intarsia allows you to "paint" with yarn to create beautiful images in your knitting. Discover this fascinating colorwork technique in this 3-hour class with Michele. Our class project is an argyle hot pad that you can proudly use on your table or give as a gift.



Pre-requisites Skills: This class is suitable for an advanced beginner/intermediate knitter. Attendees should be very comfortable with knitting and purling.

Supplies List:

- Completed homework
- Three colors of worsted weight 100% wool (feltable) yarn (a class kit containing this is available for purchase at The Flaming Ice Cube for \$8.95)
- US10 knitting needles
- Stitch markers
- Tapstry needle
- Scissors
- Yarn bobbins (optional)

Homework: With main color and long-tail cast on, cast on 41 stitches and knit 6 rows.

Class time: 3 hours

Cost: \$30
